

In person lessons bad weather arrangement*

*The bad weather arrangement will not impact online lessons. Online lessons shall commence as usual.

A) For classes not yet started**

For Red or Black Storm Signal:

If Hong Kong Observatory announces the red or black storm signal	
At or before 11:59am	All in person lessons before 12:00 nn will be changed to online.
Between 12:00nn and 2:59pm	All in person lessons between 12:00nn and 5:00pm will be changed to online.
Between 3:00pm and 5:00pm	All in person lessons after 3:00pm will be changed to online.

For typhoon signal no.8 or above:

When typhoon signal no.8 or above is hoisted	
At or before 11:59am and the signal is cancelled or lowered before 12:00nn	All in person lessons before 2:00pm will be changed to online. Lessons after 2:00pm will not be affected
At or before 11:59am and the signal is not cancelled or lowered before 12:00nn	All in person lessons after the time of announcement will be changed to online.
After 12:00nn	
When typhoon signal no.8 or above is announced by the Hong Kong Observatory to be hoisted within 2 hours:	
At or before 11:59am and the signal is not cancelled or lowered before 12:00nn	All lessons after the time of announcement will be changed to online.
After 12:00nn	

**Students can proactively reach out to Cana to reschedule the lessons if needed.

B) *For classes already started*

For both red/black storm signal and typhoon signal no.8 or above:

Classes will continue. After the end of classes:	
Students who are over 18 years-old	can either leave on their own or stay in the centre until the front desk is closed.
Students who are under 18 years-old	need to seek their parents' consent that they can leave on their own.

When Typhoon Signal No.3 or Yellow Rainstorm Signal is hoisted, it should be assumed that all class(es) will be held as scheduled unless a special announcement has been made (in which case students will be notified by phone).
